The Outreach Program tries to be preventative in helping families avoid illegal absences. The Outreach Coordinator makes phone calls to families to remind them to turn excuses in. Also, if there are students absent for an extended period of time with the school not knowing why, the Outreach Coordinator will make phone call attempts and if unsuccessful will make home visits.

### Data Teams and Grade Level Meetings

The teachers will be able to have common planning time each and every day throughout the school year. During this time, once per week, the teachers will be required to get together and have a grade level meeting. The purpose of these meetings is to keep everyone on the same page, work through any problems with the new reading series, and adjust curriculum/pacing by using data driven decision making.
