Reserved Parking Spot Guidelines & Procedures 2021-2022

Step 1: Submit the Reserved Parking Spot Contract and Design Approval by August 6th, 2020.

- You and your parents should carefully read and sign the Reserved Parking Spot Contract.
- A school appropriate and approved design for your parking spot **MUST** be included with the signed contract. OCHS will keep this, so make a copy for yourself. All spaces must

be personalized or marked in some manner to indicate to other students that your space is reserved.

- To ensure your design is approved before the designated painting time, submit your contract and your design to Mr. Stahl or Mrs. Shuffstall at the high school office by **August 6th, 2021**. You will be contacted if there is a problem with your design.

Step 2: Parking permit, spot, and painting your spot. August 9 & 10. (Talk to Mr. Stahl or Mrs. Fulmer if you need to make arrangements for another time).

- Parking spots will be assigned on a first come first served basis. If you want to collaborate with a friend and need side by side spots then be sure to show up on time. Some spots will be restricted.
- Have your \$10 to purchase a parking permit (if you didn't already do so when you dropped off your contract and design approval).
- Personalize your parking spot by creating a design that reflects your interests, shows your school spirit, or simply incorporates an interesting or creative design. Remember, all reserved parking spots must be personalized in some manner to indicate to others that it is off limits to them.
- To ensure that the paint dries by the first day of school, all painting must be finished by Friday, August 20, at 4:00 pm.

- What you will need:
 - **WATER BASED INTERIOR OR EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT ONLY** (no spray paint).
 - Chalk to sketch your design before painting.
 - Your copy of your approved design.
 - Paint brushes, paint rollers, paint trays, painters tape, stencils, trash bags and any other painting supplies you think you may need.
 - **Friends and family to help you.**
 - A **limited** supply of paints and tools will be available. We cannot guarantee we will have the exact tools or paint that you need for your design.

- Be mindful of the weather- please wear a hat, bring lots of water, sunscreen, etc.

- Paint can be expensive, so here are some tips to keep the cost down:
 - Paint stores (Home Depot, Sherwin Williams, etc.) have mis-tinted paints for a discount, usually under \$10.
 - Ask family, neighbors, and grandparents if they have paint lying around that they aren't using (you can usually get it tinted at a home supply store).
 - Talk to your friends about what colors they are using, then go in together on the paint.
 - Simplify your design, more colors=more money.

- **Step 5: Enjoy your parking spot!**
 - Your spot is reserved for the entire 2021-2022 school year.

- I understand that I may need to provide my own paint and supplies as the school has limited supplies.
- I will only paint school appropriate designs that have been pre-approved.
- I understand that all painting **must be finished by 4:00 pm on Friday August 20, 2021.**
- I understand that my parking spot is reserved during school hours only and that I do not have exclusive access to that spot on weekends or evenings.

If I do not abide by all these rules I understand that my parking spot will be taken away and painted over and that I will not receive a refund.


